

### IDEAS FOR WASTE-FREE LUNCHBOX

Did you know that Kinma has a policy of minimal waste?

Here are some ideas to help the community reduce packaging in lunch boxes.

### **BULK SHOPS**

There is a number of shops offering a good variety of wrap-free produce on the Northern Beaches. Check them out for snacks, rice, pasta, pulses, grains, flours, spices and other stuff.

Local Woolworths, Coles and Harris Farm also often sell some produce in bulk, such as **dried truit** and **snacks**. You don't have to take a new sealing bag every time you buy these - it's perfectly fine to reuse yours as long as you buy the product you put in (sadly, I often see even the new bags overfilled and left at the scale; be aware that the policy supermarket prevents resale of these).

Other items that can be commonly purchased without any wrapping include:

sushi rolls in sushi takeaway places (in BYO box; refill the little fish with soy sauce at home)
dolmades and olives in supermarkets (some shops will weight your own containers - check first)



### ROASTED SEAWEED

A package of 100 sheets of roasted seaweed can be purchased in some Asian shops, for example, Asian City Supermarket (369 Victoria Ave, Chatswood, approx. \$31). One such package lasts for weeks or months. Cut the sheets with scissors into small pieces and put them in a sealed sandwich bag. The seaweed keeps reasonably crunchy for a couple of hours when sealed well. Alternatively, you can add a silica bag or capsule salvaged from another product. If your child is in preschool, please make sure the silica is secured so that no little explorer can accidentally open it and eat it (assuming that Primary children understand this), for example by sewing it inside a little fabric pouch
